



8. How to get to Yonsei University International Campus in Songdo, Incheon

- from Incheon Int'l Airport by subway
- 1) Take the Incheon Airport Train at the airport and get off at the station "Gyeyang".
- 2) Transfer to "Incheon1" line and take the train bound for "Campus Town" station
- 3) Get off at the station "Campus Town" and walk to Yonsei University International Campus.
- from Incheon Int'l Airport by bus
- 1) Take the bus #303 or #303-1 at the bus stop 2A and get off at the bus stop "The Prau".
- 2) Walk from the bus stop "The Prau" to the bus stop "Songdo Poonglim Iwant 2-danji".
- 3) Take the bus #M6724 at the bus stop "Songdo Poonglim Iwant 2-danji" and get off at the bus stop "Yonsei University" (need to walk 9 minutes to Yonsei Univ. after getting off).

9. Other Information

- 1) Weather: The hot months of summer last from June to early September in Korea. Half of the annual rainfall occurs during the monsoon season from late June to early July. Mid-July through mid-August is the hottest period and the most popular time for Koreans to go on vacation.
- 2) Insurance: Please make sure that you have adequate travel insurance before leaving your home country. Remember that travel insurance costs just a few dollars, but it could save thousands if things go wrong.








- Drinking Makgeolli




- Flashmob




