Program

Day 1-5:

Young environmental activists from Belarus, Slovenia and Germany will get to know different urban gardening projects in Hanover. We will visit facilities such as the school biology center, the district farm and the adventure nature garden, where children and young people work on the topics of gardening and nature.



Day 6-10:

After staying in Hannover, we will take the train to Oberweimar near Marburg. We will take a look at UNESCO-protected “Bergpark Wilhelmshöhe” in Kassel, before arriving at the „Petersilie“ gardening collective in the evening. There we will spend the remaining five days getting to know the project which set up by young people. We will get insights into their life, the project, their educational workshops, cultivation methods and community-supported agriculture. We will also have a chance to help with their gardening activities. A day trip to beautiful Marburg is also planned. During the stay at the “Petersille” community, we could also go to other nearby places, hang out at a campfire, exchange ideas and perspectives, swim and develop our own ideas for future projects.

Food:

The food provided is only vegetarian and vegan.

In Hannover we will have several lunches together, for example in the university cafeteria, paid by organizers. There meat dishes are also available.

Accommodation:

In Hanover we will stay together in a youth center on the outskirts of the city. There are four rooms with mattresses, a kitchen, a dining area, a terrace and a garden, four toilets with their own sinks, but only one shower!
